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Presidents Report

At the **General Meeting** in June, President John Lyon explained how the **Arbour Project** should look like using artist impression slides.

The location of the Arbour will be adjacent to the children's play area in the Village Green, opposite the Buderim Memorial Hall. On one side it will display historical placards of the Buderim Garden Club's 75 years of operation, and on the other side there will be a similar display of BWMCA's activities.

The BGC meeting unanimously **approved the BGC donation of \$10,000** towards the Project. This is in addition to the \$2,000 contribution to costs of the feasibility study. The total contributions from BGC and BWMCA (\$10 000 each) and \$5,000 from Councillor Ted Hungerford will allow the project to be fully funded.

Changes to constitution :

The general meeting in June unanimously adopted the following proposals for a change to the constitution :

New Rule 21 : Meetings by using communication technology

- (1) The management committee may hold meetings, or permit members to take part in its meetings, by using any technology that reasonably allows members to take part in meetings.
- (2) A member of a management committee or member who participates in a meeting under subsection (1) is taken to be present at the meeting.

Change to Rule 34 : Procedure at general meeting

- (1) A member may take part and vote in a general meeting in person, or by using any technology that reasonably allows the member to take part or vote on the discussions.
- (2) A member who participates in a meeting as mentioned in subrule (1) is taken to be present at the meeting.

Note – There are several other minor changes to update the constitution to modern times :

- Add to members Information (d) their phone/mobile details; & (e) Email address details;
- Add Vice President position to Committee, 8 committee members instead 9 (still 12 total).
- The secretary must ensure full and accurate minutes of all questions, matters, resolutions and other proceedings of each management committee meeting are entered in a minute book (electronic copy allowed).

For those of you who cannot visit our Webpage here are some details of this year's Festival
The 2021 Buderim Garden Festival will run from **Friday 15 October (3pm)** to **Sunday 17 October**.

The **Festival** has traditionally attracted gardeners and interested spectators from around the state. The Festival will centre in and around the Buderim War Memorial Hall (corner of Main and Church Streets, Buderim). A major feature of the Festival is the **competitive Spring Flower Show** including cut flowers, potted plants, foliage, hanging baskets, bonsai plants and garden photography.

This year, the theme of the Festival is "Blue and White", always popular in gardens.

Adjacent to the hall there will be a **Quality Plant Market** selling a wide variety of garden plants such as bromeliads, gerberas, orchids, staghorns, ferns, roses, geraniums, cottage garden plants, begonias, cacti, succulents and garden novelties.

The **Flower Show** and **Quality Plant Market**, based at the Hall, will be open from - **Friday 15 Oct (twilight session) 3-7pm**, **Saturday 8am-4pm** and **Sunday 8am-2 pm**. The Friday twilight session will include a sausage sizzle and coffee & cakes available from the adjacent craft cottage, which will also be open displaying a **Garden Sculpture Exhibition**.

There will be **Exclusive Open Gardens in the Buderim area** which are selected to showcase the diversity in size and style of gardening in our area. Visitors will be able to see the Open Gardens without traffic and parking problems via a free small bus service operating from the Hall. The gardens **will be open Saturday 8am-4pm and Sunday 8am-3pm**.

An inclusive weekend Festival ticket for all of the above is \$15.00, or **\$2 entry** to the Spring Flower Show in the main hall and the Garden Photography in the Hall foyer. Pre-Festival tickets will be available at **Manawee Nursery**,

Old Buderim P.O., Buderim Newsagent or Buderim Bendigo Community Bank and the Hall during the Festival.

We welcome bus groups, and a discount to \$12 is available for pre-booked groups of 10 or more. Book on 0448 714 561 or buderimgardenclub@gmail.com (payments can be made on line or by cheque in the mail).

Please book as early as you can, so that arrangements can be made for your tickets to be sent or, these can be picked up at the Hall on the day of your trip.

The **Craft Cottage**, adjacent to the Hall, is the home of Buderim's artists, potters and sculptors who will present their exhibitions including "**The Sculptured Garden**" which features sculptures, along with unique planters, outdoor wall art and functional and decorative pottery.

Next door to the Hall is **St Mark's Church** which will be decorated with floral arrangements. Light refreshments will be available on site at the Craft Cottage, with the Buderim Village Green across the road being an ideal place to wander and picnic.

We have two local co-sponsors - the **Manawee Garden Centre** and the **Buderim Bendigo Community Bank** branch. Manawee Garden Centre is one of QLD's best nurseries and is within easy walking distance from the Hall. The official opening is at 2 pm Sat. 16th October. On Sunday 17th, the Monster Raffle will be drawn at 1.00 pm and the Festival will finish at 2 pm.

COMING EVENTS:

75th Anniversary lunch will be held on **Friday 13th August @ Buderim Tavern** (cost \$36/head). We are limited to 110 attendance, so book early. Details have been emailed to all members on 26th May.
